

To mark the milestones of 50th & 20th anniversaries of the 1972 World Heritage Convention and the 2003 Intangible Cultural Heritage Convention. Aarya was invited by UNESCO headquarters, Paris, to provoke the Preamble as the 'Voice from the Future' at The UNESCO Naples Conference on Cultural Heritage in the 21st century at Naples, Italy. The conference was organized by UNESCO and the Cultural Ministry of Italy where 200 experts from 104 nations gathered together to discuss global challenges in heritage.

As the youngest speaker to deliver her 10 minute speech, Aarya emphasized that advancing the endeavor to protect shared heritage over generations is essential for humanity's future. Let us not forget that it is our shared and equal responsibility to restore, preserve and value our glorious cultural heritage.
